Book Trailers:

Essential Question: How can I convince others to read a book using windows movie maker?

- 1. Read the book
- Create a list of words from the book—play word association. The words could be places, people, things, emotions, atmosphere, theme...for example; in the Jenna Fox video the color blue was prominent in the book (blue gel) so the designer of the book trailer used the color blue for backgrounds in the slides.
- 3. Determine what theme you want to express in your book trailer. Remember not to give away the ending.

- 6. Make sure you note your sources. Open and save a word document to list your sources. You will be adding this list to your credits.
- 7. Save your images, sounds, and word document listing your sources in a folder on your H drive.
- 8. Plan the order in which you will use the images and sounds.
- 9. Experiment with windows movie maker and begin adding your images, sounds, and credits.
